The Housing and Redevelopment Authority of Hibbing (HRA) encourages the public to attend a public hearing for the proposed adoption of a Moving to Work (MTW) Plan. The proposed MTW Plan would affect all non-elderly, non-disabled residents of public housing under the jurisdiction of the HRA of Hibbing.

The purpose of the hearing is to inform the public about the MTW Plan, and encourage the public to comment and ask questions. Pursuant to Notice PIH-2018-17 (FR-5994-N-04 FR/Vol. 83, No. 197/10-11-2018), all relevant documents and other pertinent information, including the Draft MTW Plan and other project documents developed for the proposal, as well as written views received from local, state, and federal agencies, will be available for public inspection and copying. Comments will be received either written or verbally by a recorder, and will become part of the official public hearing record. The comments will be considered when making future MTW-related decisions.

The proposed plan includes requesting waivers from certain federal regulations on rent structures, work requirements and mandatory participation in self-sufficiency programs. The purpose of the plan is to encourage and assist residents in reaching economic self-sufficiency.

Copies of the draft MTW Plan, which further documents the purpose and need of the program along with the anticipated impacts and timelines, are available for public inspection and copying during business hours beginning Thursday, October 22, 2020 at the following locations:
